The mission of First Assembly is to turn ordinary people into passionate followers of Jesus Christ. Specific trip details and schedules may be modified as a result of political unrest, natural disaster, group well-being, crisis, etc. All participants are expected to remain supportive and flexible. Team members and leaders will adhere strictly to the ministry policies and rules and are subjected to dismissal for disobedience - this applies for the entire four months preceding the mission trip. Team members and staff serve at their own risk and First Assembly of God is not liable in the event of sickness, accident, death, or terrorist acts. All donations received by First Assembly of God go toward project expenses. To receive a tax deduction, the IRS stipulates that the donor must release control of the money donated to the non-profit organization and money cannot be designated to a person. Thus, the individual will be a fund-raiser and will get credit for raising funds equal to the price of the trip. If an individual is unable to participate in the mission trip, the funds he or she has raised, less incurred expenses and administrative fees, will remain credited to her account for future ministry. The mission experience includes intense physical activity including, extended hiking, continuous walking, and strenuous choreography. We require that participants be in good physical condition.
